2.	Public Open Session	
2.1	Ivor Sadler raised the issue of the lack of cutting of roadside verges. It had previously been agreed that the Parish Council would take this role on.	
	On 1 <sup>st</sup> July Ivor had chased Cllr Phillips and asked when the verges would be cut. In mid-August a small amount of roadside cutting was done but not completed. It was Ivor Sadler's belief that on 1 <sup>st</sup> July when a farmer is at his busiest it's not the best time to ask for road verges to be cut.	
	The parish council agreed to give Cllr Phillips to opportunity to respond.	RP
	POST MEETING NOTE: Councillor Phillips's response - "After Ivor contacted me I spoke to Tommy Brown within 10 days. I then reminded him about 10 days later & he said he would attend to the matter & that at this stage it was really only necessary to attend to the section of the lane below the Hollies entrance as this was really the only section that the verge impinged upon & caused narrowing. It was agreed he would do that section & then the whole lane in the autumn. If it is agreed I will arrange for him to do the whole lane in early August in future years."

	Cllr Dixon reported that Stainton needed a new noticeboard, he agreed to speak to Bill Barker about a replacement. <i>Update 15/09/22: Cllr Dixon reported that he would make a smaller noticeboard for Stainton.</i> Downholme also requires a new noticeboard which the Parish Clerk will source, Cllr Peacock offered a grant to cover the costs. <i>Update 17/11/22: The Parish Clerk confirmed that funding had been received and she was waiting for confirmation of Downholme's preferred noticeboard. Cllr Barker waiting for written quote, work can be started in February 2023. Update 16/02/23: Cllr Barker confirmed that an order had been placed for a new Downholme noticeboard. Cllr Dixon has repaired Stainton's board and it will be reinstated asap. <i>Update 18/05/23: As before. 	Just before the financial year end, a grant of £174 had been received from RDC in connection with the Kings Coronation. There were no stipulations connected with the money. 	Cllr Peacock reported that she had been asked for safety signs on the Reeth Road, following the fatal crash involving a motorcycle. A full report is expected which we could act upon, a site visit could be arranged. Update 21/09/23: Following any serious accident a full investigation is carried out, the outcome and recommendations are awaited.

	Cllr Dixon asked if we could consider purchasing a defibrillator for Stainton. It was felt inappropriate for a small hamlet, but it was suggested that Wathgill should be the first stop in an emergency. Cllr Dixon agreed to make enquiries with the camp. <i>Update 21/09/23: Ongoing</i> .	JD

	Cllr Chapman had been asking around to see if any hedgehogs have been seen in the parish. He had spoken to the National Trust Ranger who suggested the initiative was for built up areas, not specifically the countryside. It was felt that the village had enough escape routes for hedgehogs.
